2023 WORLD CHICKEN FESTIVAL RULES AND REGULATIONS <u>APPLIES TO ALL VENDORS</u>

The WCF opens Thursday, September 21 at 5:00pm and runs thru Sunday, September 24, 2023 at 5:00pm. Due to the continued growth of the festival it has become necessary to create and enforce certain rules that all vendors must comply with for the safety of our vendors and visitors to the festival. Be aware that periodically during the festival officials may make booth inspections and you will be required to comply with their requests.

- 1. Vendors must bring their own tent(s) to cover their booth space, table, chairs and at least **100 feet of extension cord.**
- 2. Set up and tear down is 100% completely your responsibility
- 3. Absolutely no food or drinks can be sold or given away, unless it is an official Food Booth that falls within our guidelines.
- 4. No sale of alcoholic beverages or drug paraphernalia
- 5. No electric heaters
- 6. No animals as per City Ordinance 2012-01
- 7. All vendors must stay open each day of the festival during the hours of operation
- 8. No subleasing or sharing of booths
- 9. No undesirable items will be sold. The WCF organization will consider an undesirable as (but not limited to) stink bombs, swords, knives, silly string, potato guns, dart guns, marshmallow guns or any other projectile object, obscene or offensive material and any item deemed inappropriate by the WCF officials.
- 10. All vendors must maintain all materials within the confines of their rented space. Streets and sidewalks must remain clear.

- 11. Storage space for excess product is not provided.
- 12. All closed streets within the festival area must be kept vacant of parked cars at all times. Parked vehicles on closed streets will be towed at the operator's expense.
- 13. No more than 3 bales of hay may be used in the rented space. If you have any hay you will also need a fire extinguisher readily available.
- 14. Parking for vendors is available around the perimeter of the festival but not provided.
- 15. No operating of generators or other machinery that impacts your neighbor.
- 16. NO booths can move once the festival begins on Thursday.
- 17. All raffles must be registered and approved by the WCF committee and must meet the state raffle standards. For a list of raffle requirements call the Department of Charitable Gaming 1-502-573-5528 or visit their website at dcg.ky.gov
- 18. All food booths must have mats to cover the streets before festival opens.
- 19. All food booths have to have a fire extinguisher readily available.
- 20. All food booths need to be considerate of your neighbor. If using a grill it must be enclosed to keep smoke and grease away from your neighbor.
- 21. Sales tax must be paid by all vendors to the Kentucky Revenue Department.
- 22. Food booths will be inspected by the local health department.

WHEN YOU SIGN THE APPLICATION AND RETURN IT, YOU HAVE ENTERED INTO AN AGREEMENT TO ABIDE BY THESE REGULATIONS AND FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN EXTRA CHARGES AND/OR EXPULSION FROM THE FESTIVAL
